**Make a Difference**

This is your chance to gather your friends, family or working cohorts and make a difference ....and it's the right thing to do, you do enjoy our waterways don't you?

**Come Prepared**

Many areas in need of cleaning are located in the wetlands. Dress Appropriately-Work Boots -preferably long ones as you'll be in shallow water.

Old clothing, let's face it-you're in the mucky marsh! Grasses tend to be thick and sharp

Feel free to bring tools such as shovels, rakes or pitchforks.

**Step with Caution**

Coastal Marshes are a crucial ecosystem. The plants provide food and shelter to many mammals, birds, fish and invertebrates-it is one of the most criti-

cal plant communities on the continent..so watch where you are walking and spread apart so as little damage is done to our delicate ecosystem as possible! Only pick up trash that has not established itself in the marsh. Walk the edge of the wetland and reach in to disturb as little as possible.
