Maryland Coastal Bays Program Scholarship Guidelines



DEADLINE: April 4, 2024

The Maryland Coastal Bays Program (MCBP), a 501(c)(3) non-profit and National Estuary Program, works to enhance the ecological values and resiliency of the Coastal Bays, their watersheds, and their communities through conservation and public engagement.

MCBP will be offering three scholarships valued at \$1,000 each to qualifying high school seniors from Worcester County Public Schools interested in pursuing a future in the environmental field.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be pursuing a 4-year or 2-year college or university, trade school, or Corps position in the environmental field, including, but not limited to: environmental studies, environmental science, biology, marine science, forestry, soil sciences, environmental and outdoor education, renewable energy, computer science, smart technology, Geographic Information Systems, earth science, environmental literacy, restoration, ecology, or a related field.
- Applicants must be a student of Worcester County Public Schools.
- Applicants must be graduating from high school in Spring 2025.
- Financial need will not be considered.
- The scholarship money will be disseminated through Worcester County Public Schools.

- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- The essay portion must be typed, but the general information may be hand written (needs to be legible).
- Please include one letter of recommendation from a teacher, community member, or environmental professional that is familiar with your work ethic.
- Please include your resume outlining your leadership, work, and volunteer experience.
- Applications must include a copy of acceptance into a college or university, community college, trade school, or Corps program (AmeriCorps, Conservations Corps, etc).
- Official transcripts from applicants school.

Funding for this scholarship program is provided by the federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law through the Environmental Protection Agency.

All applicants will be considered without attention to race, color, religion, sex, age, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, veteran status, genetic information, or any other basis prohibited by law.
