### Environmental Internship Program

The Maryland Coastal Bays Program is seeking qualified applicants for a summer internship with a focus in environmental science. We are looking for highly motivated upper level undergraduates or recent graduates majoring in environmental science, environmental studies, biology, or other related fields.

Primary responsibilities include assisting with wetland assessments, anadromous fish monitoring, and data entry and analysis. Additional responsibilities include property maintenance and native vegetation plantings, assisting with diamondback terrapin surveys, water quality monitoring, writing educational articles, and assisting with outdoor education programs.

Desired Qualifications:

- Current upper level undergraduates or recent graduates in environmental science, environmental studies, biology, or other related fields.
- Basic computer skills including PowerPoint, Word, and Excel.
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a small, dynamic team.
- Ability to work outside in a variety of conditions and able to lift 25 pounds.

This position will run for 10 weeks at 32 hours a week from late May through early August. Start and end dates are flexible. This paid position is a seasonal one with no benefits.
